With a goal to better acquaint Native American children with some of the traditional activities and foods that have been a part of the Indian way of life for centuries, the TASIN Cultural Days are also an opportunity for children from the different tribes to mix with each other, creating invaluable friendships and learning experiences.

The event was held at the Soboba Sports Complex. In between cultural activities, the children had a chance to play tug-of-war, dodge ball and basketball. The sports complex is a state-of-the-art center that features a gymnasium, activity rooms, kitchen and workout facility, surrounded by baseball fields and an Olympic-sized swimming pool.

We know the participants at this year's Cultural Day enjoyed the variety of cultural events and physical activities. We look forward to another successful event next year.
