

Tribal governments understand education is the key to the future.

Throughout the state, tribal governments are giving thousands of Californians a chance at a better life through education. Thanks primarily to tribal government gaming.

Revenues from tribal government gaming are being used to fund scholarships, help struggling local schools, and support many worthwhile education programs.

- The San Manuel Band donates \$4 million to the UCLA School of Law, the school's largest donation ever.
- The Pechanga Tribe increases its annual gifts to five Temecula-area high schools to \$250,000, vowing to add two more schools to its list this year.
- The Soboba Band sponsors an event raising tens of thousands of dollars in scholarship funds for American Indian students at UC Riverside.
- The Agua Caliente Tribe gives \$135,000 to local schools, adding to the hundreds of thousands it has donated over the past several years.
- The Twenty-Nine Palms Band sponsors an innovative program for employees to earn high school diplomas.
