

California's New Economic Force

Tribal government gaming is fueling economies throughout California.

A recent study by the Rose Institute of State and Local Government found that tribal government gaming operations in Riverside County are a major economic force in the Inland Empire and throughout California.

In 2002 alone, tribal governments in Riverside County contributed to regional economies in many ways.

- **Created nearly 55,000 jobs**
- **Combined direct and indirect impact of \$1.3 billion in wages and benefits**
- **Generated \$2.4 billion in overall economic activity**
- **Made \$125 million in purchases from suppliers in Orange, Los Angeles, San Bernardino, and San Diego counties**
- **Generated more than \$400 million in federal and state income and payroll taxes, state and local sales taxes, and other payments**

According to the California Employment Development Department, job growth by tribal governments has seen an impressive 181% increase since December 2000.

The numbers tell the story.
