Tribal government gaming is doing its part for California.

Tribal government gaming is paying tens of millions in taxes each year to the state. And everyone's talking about it. It is money that is coming back to local communities throughout California, including:

- \$10.4 million in new funding for cities in Riverside County, according to the Riverside Press-Enterprise
- \$1.5 million to San Bernardino County, \$25 million over the next seventeen years, reports the San Bernardino County Sun
- Communities in Santa Barbara County will receive \$1.1 million this year, according to the Associated Press
- Local papers report \$3 million in new funding for Yolo County, \$1 million to Butte County, and \$400,000 to Tulare County

Overall, more than \$1 billion will be coming back for local police and fire protection, improved roads and infrastructure, and community programs for children and the elderly. All thanks to tribal government gaming.
