

Tribal governments understand education is the key to the future

Tribal governments are giving thousands of Californians a chance at a better life through education.

Since 2003, TASIN tribes have given millions to educate children throughout Southern California.

- The San Manuel Band donated \$4 million to the UCLA School of Law, that school's largest donation ever.
- The Pechanga Tribe increased its annual gifts to five Temecula-area high schools to \$250,000.
- The Morongo Band has contributed \$22,000 to send a high school band to New York to play Carnegie Hall and has provided \$54,000 to buy new playground equipment for Cabazon Elementary School.
- The Soboba Band sponsored an event raising tens of thousands of dollars in scholarship funds for American Indian students at UC Riverside.
- The Agua Caliente Tribe gave \$135,000 to local schools, adding to the hundreds of thousands it has donated over the past several years.
- The Twenty-Nine Palms Band sponsored an innovative program for employees to earn high school diplomas.
- The San Manuel Band also donated \$3 million to Cal State San Bernardino to pay for scholarship endowments, an internship program and a new student center.
